I never make the same mistake twice. I do it like, five or six times, you know, just to make sure.

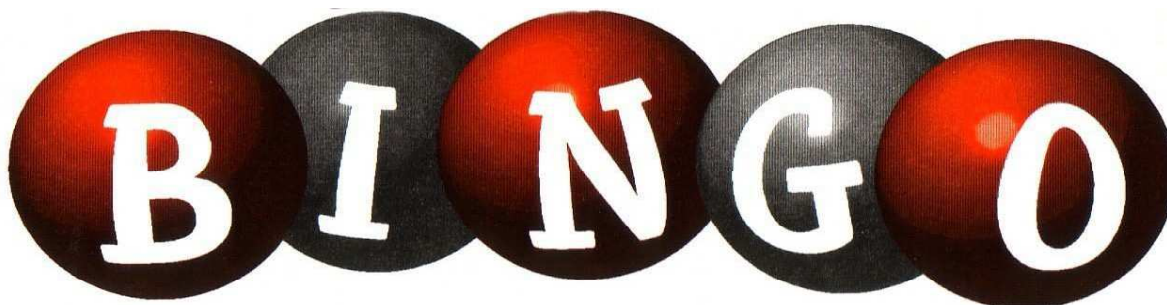
